ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Shambhu Dayal P.G. College is situated in the city of Ghaziabad adjoining the border of Delhi. Initially, this college got affiliated with the University of Agra (from 1962 to 1965) and now it is affiliated with C.C.S. University, Meerut (Since 1965). This is one of the most reputed college of the University. It has been accredited with B+ Grade by NAAC. This great centre of education came into being as a result of the resolve of the Late Shri Rai Bahadur Shambhu Dayal Ji, a great and reputed social worker and taught educationist, who founded a Trust for the social cause by donating all his property to it in the year 1917. ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The proposed workshop is a part of the Collaborative Short-term Empirical Research Project funded by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Government of India, New Delhi. The workshop will deliberate on the compilation, organization and analysis of data on the respective scheme initiative. The workshop will reflect on the achievements of PMUY over the past few years and highlight key lessons from the scheme with respect to policy design, targeting, coordination, implementation, and monitoring. It will also explore the impact of PMUY on gender, environment, and the health status of women and poor households. The workshop will commence with a keynote address followed by main speakers and speakers. It will be divided into three sessions: An inaugural session, a technical session with a panel discussion and a Valedictory session. The workshop will include presentations by experts, interactive sessions, group discussions and Q & A sessions. It will bring together various policymakers, senior officials of oil marketing companies (OMCs), sector experts, policy analysts, LPG dealers, beneficiaries of the PMUY scheme and researchers.

Objectives of the Workshop:

1. To discuss the objectives of the project;
2. To deliberate on the targets achieved;
3. To discuss the methodology of primary data;
4. To discuss the qualitative as well as the quantitative data and case studies;
5. To discuss the effectiveness and implementation of the policy initiatives;
6. To gather feedback from the stakeholders and identify major challenges;
7. To facilitate collaboration between government agencies, NGOs, and private sector stakeholders to enhance the reach and impact of the scheme.

1. Socio-Economic Analysis of PMUY.
2. Environmental Sustainability and Health Impacts.
